

Pay Your Federal Tax Liability / Federal Estimates Online

*****Pay from Your Bank Account with IRS Direct Pay*****

The IRS has a new web-based system – **IRS Direct Pay** – available on **IRS.gov** that lets you pay your tax bills or make estimated tax payments directly from your checking or savings accounts without any fees or pre-registration.

Direct Pay simplifies the payment process, and taxpayers can make a payment from the convenience of a home computer. With IRS Direct Pay, you receive instant confirmation that the payment was submitted, and the system is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Bank account information is not retained by the IRS systems after payment made.

Go to www.irs.gov and click “Make a Payment.” On the next screen, you select “Pay Now With Direct Pay.” Next select, “Make a Payment.” On the following screen, you must provide information from pulldown options.

For Federal Tax Balance Due: If the payment is for a payment due, the Reason for Payment is “Balance Due.” For Apply Payment To, you will select “Income Tax – Form 1040.” The Tax Period for Payment is the Tax Return Year you owe a balance.

For a Federal Estimated Tax Payment: If you are making an estimated tax payment, the Reason for Payment is “Estimated Tax.” For Apply Payment To, Select “1040ES” and for Tax Period for Payment, select the current year.

The next step requires ID Verification. Information required includes filing status, name, SSN or ITIN, and Date of Birth, & Address. The following step you will need your payment information, bank information, and email confirmation. Then review & sign. Save the payment confirmation for your personal records.

IRS Direct Pay offers 30-day advance payment scheduling, payment rescheduling or cancellations, and a payment status search.

*****Pay with a Debit/Credit Card or Digital Wallet*****

IRS.gov allows you to make a payment using a debit/credit card. **Processing fees apply.**

Go to www.irs.gov and click “Make a Payment.” On the next screen, select “Pay Now By Card or Digital Wallet.” Choose a payment processor from the processors provided after reviewing fees. Remember to save the payment confirmation for your records.

Pay Your State Tax Liability / State Estimates Online

*****Pennsylvania State Taxes/myPATH*****

Pennsylvania has a new web-based system – **myPATH** – available at **mypath.pa.gov** that lets you pay your tax bills or make estimated tax payments directly from your checking or savings accounts to the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue without any fees or pre-registration. **Payments made by credit/debit card are subject to convenience fees.**

With myPATH, you receive instant confirmation that the payment was submitted, and the system is available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Go to mypath.pa.gov. Select “Make a Payment” under Payments section. On the next page, select “Make a Payment.”

Then you need to enter how you would like to apply your payment:

For PA Tax Balance Due:

For account type, select “Personal Income Tax.”

For Payment Type, select “Return Payment.”

For Tax year, select tax year to apply payment

For PA Estimates Due:

For account type, select “Personal Income Tax”

For payment type, select “Estimated Payment.”

For Tax Year, select current year.

Complete your Social Security Number, your name, and your telephone number and click “Next.”

Then you will be provided payment options. You can select “ACH Debit” or “Credit/Debit Card.” There is no charge for using the ACH Debit Option. **Payments made by credit/debit card are processed by ACI Payments, Inc. and are subject to convenience fees.** Remember to save your payment confirmation for your personal records.
